"An Unexpected Surprise" Matthew 3:13-17 BAPTISM OF JESUS

INTRO: The surprise message on a gravestone

I. ONE DAY JOHN THE BAPTIST REALLY GOT A SURPRISE

- A. Jesus came to John to be baptized (verses 13-14)
- B. What is going on here?? (verse 15)
- C. How does Jesus' baptism fulfill all righteousness (v.15)?!
 - 1. A fulfillment of the children of Israel going through the river Jordan to the promised land
 - 2. A fulfillment of God's Law as the perfect sacrifice for sin
 - 3. Fully identifying with unrighteous sinners to bring us God's righteousness:"*the Great Exchange*" (2 Cor. 5:21)

II. THERE'S EVEN MORE TO THIS SURPRISE

- A. Note the first recorded words of Jesus since He was 12 years old in the Temple (v.15)
- B. These words set the tone and announce the theme for all Jesus was & came to do as His earthly ministry began
 - Words of advice to new pastors beginning their ministry
- C. The surprise of Jesus' baptism declares one central truth: He came to bear and forgive the sin of the world (Isaiah 53)
 - 1. John said to Jesus: I need to be baptized by You
 - 2. Jesus said to John: *It is God's plan that I am joined to all sinners in this baptism to <u>begin the work finished at the cross</u>*
 - 3. John tells us why *it is fitting* (John 1:29 *Behold the Lamb of God Who takes away the sin of the world*)
