Introduction: Confessing the Faith on a surgery table...

- I. PETER WAS ASKED BY JESUS: Who do you say I am?
 - A. Peter replies: You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God
 - B. Others at that time had many other opinions...
 - C. "Close but no cigar" is not close enough re: who Jesus is
- II. THE WORLD ASKS US TODAY: Who do you say Jesus is?
 - A. Former LCMS President: Get it straight and get it out!
 - B. Having right doctrine and not sharing it is NOT having right doctrine
 - C. We, like Peter deny Jesus...

III. BUT OUR LORD USES "PETERS" LIKE US TODAY

- A. Jesus calls flawed sinners (like you & me) to confess Him today
- B. He sees us through "the lens of the Cross..."
- C. Jesus is the message and the means
- D. The simple but powerful confession is this: **The forgiveness of sins** (v.19)
- E. This is called *The Office of the Keys* (v.19)
- F. Jesus gives us as he gave Peter a wonderful promise to empower our confession
