- A. In Zechariah 3 we see a heavenly court scene (Zech. 3:1-5;8-9)
- B. Jesus is our defence attorney who clears our names (Zech. 3:9; John 1:29; Col. 1:20)
- C. At our baptism into Christ Jesus, we are given a new name (Rom. 8:1)
