 - C. At all stages in our life, we find ourselves bowing to the 'authority' of those who would mislead our hearts, minds, & souls

- III. INTO OUR FALLEN, SINFUL CONDITION COMES JESUS WITH HIS LOVING AUTHORITY
 - A. In every page of Holy Scripture...
 - B. In Holy Baptism & Holy Communion...
 - C. In His precious face of agony as He is on the cross...
 - D. Oh - may we not be blinded to Jesus' authority, His authority of love
