I. FOR PETER, A RESURRECTED CHRIST MEANT RADICAL CHANGES (Acts 10)

- A. It meant changes in his eating habits
- B. It meant changes in the company he kept

II. FOR US TODAY, A RESURRECTED CHRIST MEANS RADICAL CHANGES

- A. He wants to bring together people who aren't usually seen together
- B. We live in a world where people focus on differences
- C. The Christian Church is to <u>in</u>clude, not <u>ex</u>clude

III.PETER WAS SENT BY THE RESURRECTED CHRIST TO PROCLAIM GOD'S RADICAL CHANGES

- A. God has no favourites radical! (Acts 10:34-46)
- B. Everything needed for people to belong to God forever was done at the cross (Acts 10:38-40)
- C. The crucified and risen Christ will one day return with a radical judgment (Acts 10:41-43)
- D. Just <u>look</u> at the radical changes God has brought to our present and eternal lives!

Conclusion: THE MOVIE: "HOOSIERS" - changed people: <u>that's</u> the resurrection.... and that's radical!
