- (6) And the LORD of hosts will prepare a lavish banquet for all peoples upon this mountain; a banquet of aged wine, choice pieces with marrow, and refined, aged, wine.
- (7) And on this mountain he will swallow up the covering which is over all peoples, even the veil which is stretched over all nations.
- (8) He will swallow up death for all time. And the LORD God will wipe tears away from all faces, and he will remove the reproach of His people from all the earth; for the LORD has spoken.
- (9) And it will be said on that day, "Behold this is our God for whom we have waited; let us rejoice and be glad in His salvation."

- B. Free, but not cheap (Romans 6:23)
- C. Received through trusting faith (Isa. 25:9; Eph. 2:8)
- D. By our "good looks" (Isaiah 45:22; Hebrews 12:2; Titus 2:13)

III. HEAVEN: SOMETHING TO PREPARE FOR

- A. Let's talk about our own death & burial plans
- B. So.... Why commemorate today as All Saints Day?
 - 1. Remember those who have died in the Faith
 - 2. Celebrate the victory over sin, death, devil
 - 3. <u>Prepare</u> ourselves for the reality of death & the joys of heaven
