  - A. The Pharisee: *I can do it!* (vv. 10-12)
  - B. The tax collector: *God must do it.* (v.13)
  - C. The train conductor's question "Anyone for Calvary?"
- III. SO, HOW <u>DO</u> I GET RIGHT WITH GOD?
  - A. We can try to do it ourselves (Isa. 64:6; Psalm 49:7-9), or ...
  - B. God can surely do it! (Psalm 49:7-9; Isa. 53:4-7; John 3:16)
