The Powerful Word (Isaiah 55:10-11)

Introduction: Rain is probably something that we had to learn to appreciate

I. SOME THINGS ARE NOT TRULY APPRECIATED

- A. Snow and rain always accomplish their purpose
- B. God's Word always accomplishes its God-intended purpose
- C. God's Word is not of human origin (2 Peter 1:20)

II. GOD SENT HIS WORD TO GIVE US LIFE

- A. Without God's Word we were dead in sin
- B. In Baptism and Communion, the Word connects with earthly elements
- C. If you have faith, God's powerful Word has indeed created life in you

III. HEARING THE WORD IS NECESSARY FOR OUR SOULS TO LIVE

- A. Many people doubt the power of the Word
- B. As we grow, we realize how vital the Word is to our faith-life
- C. "Faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the Word of Christ." (Romans 10:17)

IV. THE POWERFUL WORD OF GOD IS FOR EVERYONE

- A. "I am not ashamed of the gospel" (Romans 1:16)
- B. Sometimes we doubt the power of the Word in others' lives
- C. God promises that His powerful Word works!
