Sermon Outline: The Key to Life...in a Nutshell (Matthew 22:34-40)

Introduction: Have you heard the old expression – 'in a nutshell'?

- I. IN TODAY'S GOSPEL LESSON, JESUS IS ASKED TO SUM UP THE ENTIRE SCRIPTURE "IN A NUTSHELL" (Matthew 22:34-40)
 - A. Jesus is asked "What is the greatest commandment?"
 - B. Jesus says, in a nutshell... it all has to do with love for God, neighbor & self
 - C. The bad news is, we <u>cannot</u> do this: we are 'unlovely' & don't love
 - D. The good news is this: *God makes the unlovely, loveliness...* in the name of Jesus!
- II. IN A 'NUTSHELL', HERE IS A WONDERFUL TRUTH: We love because He first loved us (1 John 4:19)
 - A. God comes to us to break the sinful pattern of lovelessness!
 - B. Look to the cross to see God's love in the flesh!
 - C. Luther said "If we could understand the passion of God's love for us, our joy would be so great we would promptly die because of it!"

Conclusion: From the mouth of a 'special needs' boy, came God's love that changed countless lives for eternity...
