I. THE BIBLE TALKS ABOUT **SOLITARY PLACES**

- A. These are places one goes to make big decisions
- B. Jesus went to a solitary place to make big decision (Mk. 1:35-37)
- C. His decision was between "the kingdom of self" and the kingdom of God
- D. He chose God's kingdom (Mk. 1:38; Luke 19:10)

II. WHEN WE FOLLOW JESUS, THERE WILL BE **SOLITARY PLACES** FOR US

- A. In our various solitary places we will have to choose between "the kingdom of self" and the kingdom of God
- B. Sometimes our solitary places are places of upset & turbulence
- C. Sometimes our solitary places are quieter
- D. But—in any solitary place we will have to decide: My way or God's way?
- E. Did you know--- every Sunday sermon is your own solitary place of decision?!

Conclusion: Is every Sunday's 20 minute sermon God's solitary place for you... or is it -- "just preaching"???
