



Who Do You Think You Are? (Job 38:1-11; Mark 4:35-41)

Introduction: When have you heard the question – “*Who do you think you are?*”

[In our scripture readings today, the answer to this question always is connected to the wind, waves & sea.]

- I. **WHO DO YOU THINK YOU ARE IS WHAT JOB ASKED GOD & GOD ASKED JOB** (Job 38:1-11)
 - A. Job was suffering, he didn’t like how God was running things & wanted to set God straight.
 - B. God listened for a while and then He set Job straight **by discussing the wind, the waves & the sea** (vv. 4, 8-11)
 - C. Have you ever wanted to tell God how He should do His job?

- II. **WHO DO YOU THINK YOU ARE IS WHAT SOME DISCIPLES ASKED JESUS** (Mark 4:35-41)
 - A. The disciples were fearful, didn’t like how Jesus was seemingly ‘ignoring’ them, & wanted to set Him straight (v. 38)
 - B. Jesus listened and the set them straight **by silencing the wind, the waves and the sea** (v. 39)
 - C. When He did this He demonstrated just who He is... and we can take great comfort in that! (v.41)

- III. **THE ANSWER TO WHO DO WE THINK GOD IS & WE ARE IS GIVEN IN THE LAST BOOK OF THE BIBLE** (Revelation 21: 1-7)
 - A. Unlike suffering Job & the fearful disciples, in heaven we will have “*all tears wiped away*” (vv. 4-5)
 - B. Almighty God will dwell with us(v. 3) there will no more (heartache) **wind, waves and sea** (v.1), but we will **drink from the waters of eternal life** (v.6)
