- C. God's Word is realistic (Psalm 37:25)
  - Robert Browning's poem: "Grow Old Along with Me!"

## II. OUR MODERN WAY OF LIFE OFTEN DEVALUES OLDER PEOPLE

- A. Many modern assumptions are anti-Christian
  - the Broadway play: "Cats"
  - Rutgers University TV study
- B. But... what does God's Word say? (Proverbs 9:10-11 & Psalm 71:17-18)

## III. WRINKLES DO NOT HURT, THEY ARE A GIFT OF GOD & A LOVING REMINDER

- A. They are a gift of God, a badge of honor, a sign of mercy
- B. They tell us that this life is not our final home
- C. They can be a sign of joyful surprises
