



## Who Likes Leftovers? (Amos 5:6-15)

INTRODUCTION: The week after thanksgiving brings --- turkey leftovers!!

## I. WHO LIKES 'LEFTOVERS'?

- A. Some at the time of the prophet Amos did <u>not</u> like 'leftovers'
- B. These leftovers ("she ay reeth") were people considered worthless (Amos 5:11-15)
- C. These leftover people were treated harshly by some of Israel's leaders (vv. 11-12)

## II. TODAY WE OFTEN TREAT BADLY THE 'LEFTOVER' PEOPLE IN OUR LIVES

- A. Who are these leftovers in your life?
- B. Let's list a few of them...
- C. Jesus spoke very clearly about such people... that the way we treat them is the way we treat Him (Matthew 25)
- D. We need to hear God's word of judgment against us (Amos 5:6)
- E. Last week such a 'leftover person' walked into my church office...

## III. GOD LOVES 'LEFTOVERS'!!

- A. Here are just a few examples: Genesis 16 Hagar, 1 Samuel 1 & 2 – Hannah, Luke 19 – Zacchaeus
- B. Our dear Lord Jesus was a *she ay reeth* 'leftover', rejected by men (Isaiah 53)
- C. Dying upon the cross for you & for me, He could be seen as a 'leftover'
- D. But by His glorious resurrection, He was shown not to be a leftover, 'the main course!!'
- E. We who are considered 'leftover' by this world (1 Corinthians 1:26 ff), are precious to God
