

The Luggage of Life (Psalm 23)

Introduction: My personal challenge of "travelling light"

I. PROBABLY ALL OF US ARE NOT TRAVELLING LIGHT

- A. The heavy bags we carry are things like: a suitcase of guilt, a duffel bag of weariness, a trunk of fear.
- B. Our dear Lord invites us to <u>set these bags down and let Him carry them</u> (Matthew 11:28)
- II. GOD GIVES US AN "OLD FRIEND" TO HELP US TRAVEL LIGHT.
 - A. This old friend is **Psalm 23** (Let's read it together...)
 - B. This passage is to the Pastor what medicine is to the doctor
 - C. Psalm 23 can help you, as it has many others, to <u>set</u> down some heavy luggage.
- III. TRAVELLING LIGHT MEANS TRUSTING GOD WITH THE BURDENS YOU WERE NEVER INTENDED TO BEAR
 - A. In this New Year 2013, why not try "travelling light"?
 - B. Ever notice the impact excess baggage has on all your relationships?
 - C. Excess baggage impedes my running life... & your life of faith
