

## **SERMON OUTLINE FOR AUGUST 4, 2013**

## "Money, Stuff & More Stuff"

Luke 12:13-21

## INTRODUCTION:

Which of the following statements is not in the Bible . . .

- I. WE NEED TO DISCUSS 'MONEY & STUFF'
  BECAUSE SOME TALK ABOUT IT TODAY
  IS JUST AWFUL
  - A. Note, for example, the 'money talk' on some religious TV programs
  - B. We do not need to bribe God to get His attention (Psalm 50; Romans 8:31-32; Luke 11:13)
  - C. We believe in *barter*, *bribery*, & *bargaining*... God believes in *giving!* (John 3:16; Romans 6:23)
  - D. When asked the question,
    "What is more important: your soul or your 'money & stuff'...
    our answer often does not match the reality of our lives
- II. JESUS DISCUSSES 'MONEY & STUFF'
  IN TODAY'S GOSPEL LESSON (Luke 12:13-21)
  - A. A man came to Jesus with concerns about getting his rightful inheritance
  - B. Jesus tells the parable of the 'rich fool' to teach us an important lesson (vv. 16-21)
  - C. This is not just a nice story (Note the corpse grasping onto jewels in the ruins of Pompeii, 79 A.D.)
  - D. There is nothing wrong with 'money & stuff' as long as it does not become your god.
