## "When Doubts Come"

Matthew 11:1-11

## INTRODUCTION:

Albert Einstein & his quick thinking chauffeur

- I. THINGS AREN'T ALWAYS AS THEY SHOULD BE, ARE THEY?
  - A. John the baptizer had his doubts and so do we (Matthew 11:1-3)
  - B. There was for John & there is for us a difference between expectations & reality
  - C. John took his doubts to Jesus, and so can we (verses 2-3)
- II. WHEN THINGS AREN'T AS THEY SHOULD BE, JESUS STANDS WITH & FOR US
  - A. Jesus responds to a confession of doubt:
    - 1. He assures (verses 4-5)
    - 2. He blesses (verse 6)
    - 3. He defends (verses 7-11)
  - B. Jesus is no weakling; not just a cute baby in a manger (verses 7-9)
  - C. Jesus calls <u>us</u> "greater than John the Baptizer" (verse 11)
- III. SO, WHEN IN DOUBT...WHAT ARE WE TO DO? Jesus has taught us:
  - A. Not to keep it inside or hidden
  - B. Bring our doubts to Him, by our self or with the help of others
  - C. He will never turn us away
