"Touching the Hem of Jesus' Robe" Luke 8:40-48

INTRODUCTION: Who do you say Jesus is?

- I. WHILE ON AN IMPORTANT JOURNEY, JESUS STOPS FOR A 'NOBODY'
  - A. Jairus' daughter must wait
  - B. A nameless woman with a bleeding disorder needed Jesus
  - C. She touches the hem of Jesus' garment

## II. JESUS HAS A WAY OF STOPPING FOR NOBODIES

- A. It is the story of His entire life & ministry
- B. The nameless woman has a superstitious faith
- C. But, holding onto Jesus' hem, she is healed

III. JESUS STOPS FOR US 'NOBODIES' TODAY

- A. Whatever our 'bleeding disorder', His grace is sufficient
- B. He also suffered from a 'bleeding disorder' on the cross
- C. He gives us victory over temporary struggles & eternal death
