"Pardon Me"

Romans 8:1 & 5:1-11

- INTRODUCTION: The common expression: pardon me and also pardons from governments & courts
- I. A PARDON FROM GOD
 - A. A wonderful pardon (Romans 8:1)
 - B. Benefits from this pardon (Romans 5:1-11)
 - C. We need this pardon (Romans 3:10; 23; 6:23)
 - D. Some today think they don't need it
 - E. St. Paul once thought the same (Philippians 3:4-8)

II. A PARDON FOR OTHERS

- A. Some people will not pardon
- B. Yet we are called to pardon others (Ephesians 4:32)
- C. Note: St. Paul, Philemon & the slave Onesimus [read: the 25 verse book of Philemon!]
- D. The church is to be "a pardon place" (Romans 8:1)
- III. A PARDON TO YOURSELF
 - A. You pardoning yourself for past sins & mistakes
 - B. Living in the spirit of Romans 8:1
 - C. Being set free from your own self-made prison
 - D. Hiroo Onada: The Japanese soldier captive in his self-made island prison for 30 years pardoned at last
 - E. The LORD can pardon all that has been wrong in your life (Psalm 103:12)
- CONCLUSION: Jesus is the LORD of your *unchangeable past* & your *unpredictable future*.
