"Giving with a Cheerful Heart"

2 Corinthians 9:6-15

INTRODUCTION: "Planting grass seeds generously..."

I. GIVING ORIGINATES WITH GOD

- A. He has showered His grace upon us in abundance (2 Corinthians 9:8-10)
- B. Luther's explanation of the 1st article of the Apostles' Creed says it so well

II. CHARACTERISTICS OF CHRISTIAN GIVING

- A. A thankful & trusting heart is used by God to accomplish great things
 - 1. L. Kraft of Kraft Cheese Corporation & his 25%
 - 2. Zacchaeus the tax collector & his changed heart (Luke 19)
- B. KEY POINT: The love of Jesus changes our hearts & empowers us to be "givers" and not just "takers" (2 Corinthians 9 & Luke 19)
- C. Never under compulsion, but with thankful cheerfulness
 - 1. Such giving also clearly applies to marriage
 - 2. Reluctant giving reveals a *plumbing problem* in our lives ("plugged up pipes")
- D. ONLY <u>Jesus' self-giving sacrifice</u> forgives our sins & changes our hearts

III. GREAT RESULTS OF GIVING

- A. Generosity brings blessings to many
- B. "What goes around, comes around" says St. Paul (2 Corinthians 9:12-13)
