- B. Imagine what went through His mind before He left
- C. Finally the day came to journey toward the cross

III. ***Jesus decided to leave for Galilee . . .*** (v. 43)

- A. He could have refused to go, but His heart said go
- B. He heard the voices crying out in need
- C. He saw the faces . . . from Adam until today
- D. He heard your voice and saw your face
- E. He left because of you!
