INTRODUCTION:

I. BEING A PARENT MEANS “TAKING CARE OF BUSINESS”

- A. Providing for your child’s physical needs (1 Timothy 5:8)
- B. Providing for your child’s spiritual needs (Proverbs 22:6)

II. AS WE TRY TO TAKE CARE OF BUSINESS, THERE ARE CHALLENGES

- A. We can become physically separated from our child
 - 1. Mary & Joseph became separated from young Jesus (Luke 2:44)
 - 2. There is no more hopeless feeling than to have a lost child . . .
- B. We can become spiritually separated from our child
 - 1. Remember the “prodigal son”? (Luke 15)
 - 2. Where are our children spiritually?

- B. What was His Father’s business at the cross?
- C. What is His Father’s business now in & through the Church?
