# The Observatory: A Heavenly Love

(Matthew 6:9)

INTRODUCTION: My "wisdom & majesty" for a little school girl & God's <u>true</u> wisdom & majesty

## I. GOD DWELLS IN A WHOLE DIFFERENT REALM THAN US, & HE WANTS US TO SEE THINGS FROM HIS PERSPECTIVE

- A. He is *Our Father*, *Who is in heaven* & He has a heavenly, eternal perspective
- B. He sees & knows things we cannot comprehend; and that's good! (1 Corinthians 1:25; Isaiah 55:8-9)
- C. Today we are invited to see things from **God's Observatory** . . . to see <u>His perspective</u>

### II. OUR FATHER, WHO IS IN HEAVEN RULES THE UNIVERSE, YET ALSO LOVES YOU!

- A. The heavens declare His glory, yet even they cannot hold Him (Psalm 19:1; 2 Chronicles 2:6)
- B. Yet this same almighty God "so loved the world that He sent His only begotten Son..." (John 3:16)
- C. And the good news is *Our Father*, *Who is in heaven* always sees us from a wonderful perspective: He sees us through the cross of Jesus

### III. LET'S LOOK AT SOME THINGS FROM GOD'S PERSPECTIVE... FROM HIS OBSERVATORY

- A. Behold the wonder of our sun . . . just 1 minor star of the 100 billion in our galaxy
- B. Consider our earth . . . it's 23 degree "tilt", it's 1000 mils per hour spin, it's gravity
- C. As you see God's creation, now see your life <u>from God's perspective</u>
  - 1. If He can put the sky & stars in their places, do you think He can care for you?
  - 2. If He is mighty enough to ignite the sun, do you think He can light your path?
  - 3. If He cares enough about the planet Saturn to give it rings, do you think He can meet your needs?
- D. Jesus answers all these questions in Matthew 6:25 and ff as He invites you to step into **God's Observatory** to see all creation & your life from a whole new perspective.
- E. Why did God give us such a beautiful creation? (Why do you give special gifts?)
- F. Hear God say to you: Do you like it? Isn't it great? I did it for you. Oh, yes, I love you!
- G. Hear God say the same thing about His gift of Jesus . . . (John 3:16)
