Upside Down <u>IS</u> Right Side Up

(Mark 1:7)

INTRODUCTION: *In almost every area of life:*

"up" is good & "down" is bad, but ...

I. AS DISCIPLES OF JESUS:

DOWNWARD, SMALLER, LESSER IS BETTER

- A. Note these passages that show us -- upside down is right side up
 - 1. Mark 1:7
 - 2. Mark 9:34
 - 3. Matthew 16:24
 - 4. John 3:30
 - 5. John 1:29
- B. The life & example of John the Baptizer shows us the way

II. JESUS HIMSELF IS <u>THE MODEL</u> OF **UPSIDE DOWN IS RIGHT SIDE UP**

- A. He gave up His place in heaven to come down to us as our Saviour
- B. He who was the highest became the lowest... at the cross
- C. Paul describes this beautifully in Philippians 2:5-11
- D. Jesus explains this so well in Mark 10:45

III. AS DISCIPLES OF JESUS, <u>WE</u> WANT TO LIVE THE TRUTH OF **UPSIDE DOWN** <u>IS</u> RIGHT SIDE **UP**

- A. We strive to be like John the Baptizer, "decreasing" so Jesus can "increase"
- B. We reexamine why we "come to church"
- C. We come to: lift up the name of Jesus, serve God & others, & bring another person with us
- D. As individuals & a congregation we DON'T ask: "What's in it for me?"
- E. We DO ask:

"What best serves God & the eternal needs of others?"
