A. It is the story of His entire life \& ministry
B. The nameless woman has a superstitious faith
C. But, holding onto Jesus' hem, she is healed

## III. JESUS STOPS FOR US 'NOBODIES’ TODAY

A. Whatever our 'bleeding disorder', His grace is sufficient
B. He also suffered from a 'bleeding disorder' - on the cross
C. He gives us victory over temporary struggles \& eternal death
