I. MANY OF US HANDLE OUR AGING BY DENYING IT

- A. We tell ourselves we are not getting older
 - 1. My doctor tells me I have "old age disease" ©
 - 2. We do everything we can to hide it . . .
- B. Some live in a make believe world where no one ages . . . or everyone does but me
 - 1. The 50th high school reunion
 - 2. Living in "Neverland" with Peter Pan
- C. God's Word is realistic (Psalm 37:25)
 - 1. Young folks: "You ain't seen nuthin' yet!"
 - 2. Robert browning's poem: "Grow Old Along with Me!"

II. OUR MODERN WAY OF LIFE OFTEN DEVALUES OLDER PEOPLE

- A. Many modern assumptions are anti-Christian
 - 1. The Broadway play: "Cats"
 - 2. Rutgers University study re: older people on TV
- B. But . . . what does God's Word say?

 (Proverbs 9:10-11 & Psalm 71:17-18)
- C. Let's look at the Gospel-filled promises from the classic hymn *Rock of Ages*



III. AGING CAN BE SEEN AS A GIFT OF GOD & A LOVING REMINDER

- A. A sign of God's faithfulness
- B An opportunity to teach young people the blessings of a life lived for Jesus
- C. A reminder that this life is not our final home
