- E. The Church gave thanks (Revelation 7)

II. WORDS CAN BE CHEAP, BUT THANKS IS COSTLY

- A. Just ask Daniel of lion's den fame (Daniel 6)
- B. Thanksgiving: more than a 1 day "pig-out" (Amos 5)
- C. Want to thank God? Love your "brother" (1 John 4)
- D. Paul sums it up: we are *living sacrifices* (Romans 12:1)
- E. Our thanks are in view of God's mercy (Romans12:1)
