INTRODUCTION: The meaning of "taking care of business" OR "mind your own business"


I. BEING A PARENT MEANS TAKING CARE OF SOME IMPORTANT BUSINESS

B. Providing for your child's spiritual needs (Proverbs 22:6)

 - 1. Mary & Joseph became separated from young Jesus (Luke 2:44)
 - 2. There is no more hopeless feeling than to have a lost child...
- B. We can become spiritually separated from our child
 - 1. Remembers the "prodigal son"? (Luke 15)
 - 2. Where are our children spiritually?

- B. What was His Father's business at the cross?
- C. What is His Father's business now in & through the Church?
