INTRODUCTION: Some of the most misunderstood words in the Bible . . .


I. THE BEATITUDES SEEM TO BE A LIST OF "IF-THEN" PRESCRIPTIONS

- A. This makes the Christian Faith a religion of payoffs
- B. Often we live the Christian life grudgingly with the hope of getting a payoff from God
- C. At this point the Beatitudes snap closed on us like a trap (Matthew 5:48)

II. IF WE READ THE BEATITUDES LIKE A SAYING ON A WALL POSTER, WE'RE ALSO IN TROUBLE

- A. We try to live in two worlds: "Sunday religion" & "real life"
- B. The beatitudes offer only two choices: be bless by the world's standards or by God
- C. Beatitudes as prescription OR wall poster give us no hope.

III.THE BEATITUDES ARE *DESCRIPTIONS*OF THOSE WHO ARE IN CHRIST

- A. A sinner who knows Who is their Saviour
- B. Christ Jesus Who spoke the beatitudes, is the Beatitude
- C. **Confirmands, be ready:** Persecution can be the outcome of the beatitudes (*Matthew 5:12*)
- D. Persecution, death, and victory is where the beatitudes begin!! (1 Corinthians 15:55-57)
- E. The beatitudes **describe the life of those who have life in Jesus' name now**... even when the world around us can't see it!

CONCLUSION: Jesus' eternal promise: Blessed <u>are</u> You! (Revelation 2:10)
