INTRODUCTION: Why our worship begins

with confession of sin &

30 people who left the church

because of it . . .

I. REPENTANCE LEADS TO TRUE WORSHIP (Psalm 95)

- A. Let us, let us, let us . . . (Psalm 95:1-2)
 - worship is personal but NOT individual
- B. So says Hebrews 10:24-25
 - meeting together/encouraging each other
- C. Confession & forgiveness leads to praise
- D. Praise flows from assurance of God's salvation (1 Samuel 4-5)



II. THE JOY OF REPENTANT FAITH CREATES A DESIRE TO WORSHIP

- A. This worship is centered on our LORD, not on ourselves (95:1)
- B. This worship reminds us who we are and Who God is (95:3-6)
- C. This worship brings humility & destroys pride (96:6; Luke 18:9-14)
 - + The current virus crisis (and any crisis) leads us to humility, repentance & trust (Go home today and read Luke 13:1-5)
- D. This worship gives us ears to listen to God & a heart to receive His gifts (95:7-8; Exodus 17:1-7; Psalm 51:17)

CONCLUSION: We will continue to begin worship with confession & absolution.
